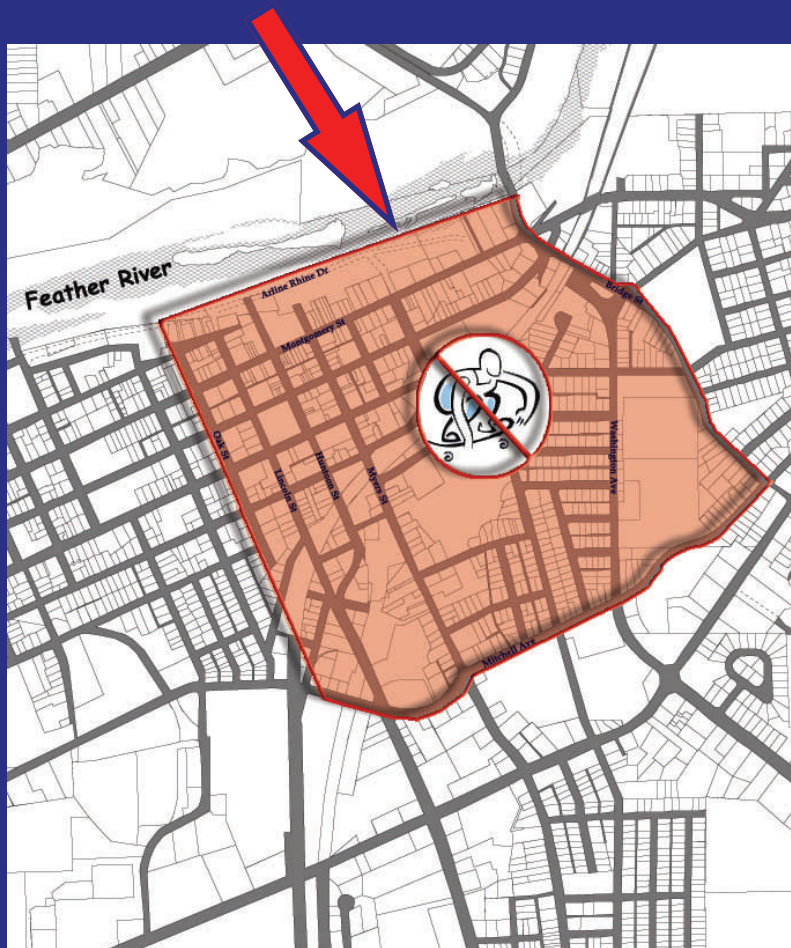
## **DOWNTOWN SKATE FREE ZONE**

And

## **SKATEBOARDING LAWS**



No person shall skateboard/skate within the prohibited area of Downtown Oroville - See map below



Every person skating in approved areas shall comply with the following:

Skate near to the right-hand side of the street as practicable and exercising due-care when passing pedestrians, standing vehicles, bicycles, and other skaters.

Skate in direction of vehicular and bicycle traffic (on the same side of the street).

Skate facing the direction of vehicular and bicycle traffic (on the same side of the street).

Skate in single file, except when passing other skaters.

Yield the right-of-way to all approaching vehicles, bicycles, pedestrians when emerging onto a street from an alleyway, driveway, or sidewalk .

Obey the instructions of all traffic-control signs and other devices unless directed by a police officer.

- 22-63 OCC Rolling skating on city street — Prohibited except within crosswalks and on designated streets
- 22-64 OCC Roller skating on public sidewalks — Prohibited within designated areas of the downtown business district.

- 22-66 OCC Roller skating on designated street — Rules of the road
- 22-67 OCC Compliance with rules of the road applicable to pedestrians.
