

CITY OF OROVILLE - FIRE DEPARTMENT

BURNING REGULATIONS WITHIN OROVILLE CITY LIMITS

- ◆ A BURNING PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR OPEN DOOR YARD BURNING AND AGRICULTURAL BURNING. THE PERMIT IS VALID FROM 1/1 THRU 12/31).
- ◆ THE COST OF THE PERMIT IS \$5.00.
- ◆ PERMITS MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT AT 1735 MONTGOMERY STREET, OROVILLE, CA 95965-4897.)
- ◆ BURNING HOUR RESTRICTIONS: **CHECK YOUR PERMIT FOR TIMES AND REGULATIONS.**
- ◆ END OF FIRE SEASON: (OCTOBER/NOVEMBER-APRIL 30) - NO BURNING HOUR RESTRICTIONS
- ◆ MAY 1ST-JUNE 30TH BURNING HOURS: 6:00 A.M.-11:00 A.M. (NOTE: ALL FIRES MUST BE OUT AT 11:00 A.M.)
- ◆ JULY 1ST IS THE END OF FIRE SEASON - NO BURNING ALLOWED.
- ◆ AGRICULTURAL BURNING: CHECK WITH BUTTE COUNTY AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT DISTRICT AT 530-896-2537 FOR BURN DAYS AND/OR PERMIT.
- ◆ PERMITTEE SHALL HAVE A SUFFICIENT NUMBER OF PERSONS, INCLUDING SELF, PRESENT AT THE TIME OF BURNING TO INSURE COMPLETE SAFETY AND CONTROL.
- ◆ NO BURNING SHALL BE UNDERTAKEN UNLESS WEATHER CONDITIONS (PARTICULARLY WIND) ARE SUCH THAT THEY CAN REASONABLY BE CONSIDERED SAFE (WIND VELOCITY LESS THAN 15 MPH DURING BURNING).
- ◆ MAXIMUM PILE SIZE - FOUR (4) FEET IN DIAMETER.
- ◆ AREA WITHIN TEN (10) FEET OF THE OUTER EDGE OF PILE IS MAINTAINED FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL FLAMMABLE MATERIAL AND VEGETATION.
- ◆ HAVE WATER SUPPLY AT BURNING SITE CAPABLE OF CONTROLLING THE FIRE.
- ◆ RESIDENTIAL BURNING BY USE OF AN OPEN, OUTDOOR FIRE DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY MATERIAL FROM A BUSINESS, INDUSTRY, AGRICULTURE, OR ANY OTHER SOURCE OTHER THAN APPLICANT'S RESIDENCE.
- ◆ PERMIT DOES NOT ALLOW THE BURNING OF GARBAGE, TRASH, RUBBISH, DEMOLITION OR CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS (2X4'S, PLYWOOD, ETC.), RUBBERIZED, ASPHALT OR PETROLEUM PRODUCTS, MATERIALS FILLED WITH ANY FORM OF OIL, RESIN, ASPHALT OR RUBBER, COTTON, HEMP, WOOL PRODUCTS, CLOTHING, MATTRESSES AND/OR BEDDING.
