WHO ARE WE?

The Oroville Volunteers in Police Service (VIPS) are a team of trained citizen volunteers who assist with non-enforcement duties and provide value added services to our city. The VIPS are a tremendous asset to the Police Department and the community.

HERE ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF WHAT YOU CAN DO AS A VOLUNTEER FOR THE OROVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

Citizen Patrol

Neighborhood Patrols: Volunteers will patrol the community watching for and reporting suspicious activity.

Patrols During Special Events: VIPS are often called upon to provide car and/or foot patrols during many of Oroville's special events (Kiwans Club's Hooked on Fishing, Feather Fiesta Days, Salmon Festival, etc.)

Vacation Property Checks: VIPS provide vacation checks of property when the owners are away for a short period of time.

Community Services

Wellness Checks: VIPS check on people who may need extra assistance when their family member is away for a brief period of time.

Bicycle Safety and Helmet Program: Provides bicycle safety instruction and helmets to local children.

Administrative Duties

VIPS have the opportunity to work in the Oroville Police Department office or our office in the Centennial Cultural Center assisting other departments and the general public.
