ADOPT-A-ROAD-PROGRAM

Dear Adopt-A-Road Sponsor:

This is in response to your inquiry regarding the City of Oroville's Adopt-A-Road Program. We would certainly appreciate your group's effort in joining this program. The procedures to become an Adopt-A-Road sponsor are as follows:

1. A company or community group (sponsor) writes our department a letter requesting the area or road to be adopted.
2. The sponsor leader meets with the Public Works Director to discuss safety procedures and to complete a no fee encroachment permit application. Each of the sponsor's participants must also sign a waiver of liability form.
3. Clean-up dates are agreed upon.
4. The City of Oroville Public Works Department will install the Adopt-A-Road sign with your group's name.

Most of the clean-ups are done every three (3) months or as needed. Our department will provide hats, safety vests, and litter bags. Bags would be picked up from the roadside by the Public Works Department. Tires, furniture and other bulky items are excluded from this program. This program is geared to clean-up litter along side the City right-of-way that is adopted.

If your community group desires to formally adopt a portion of a road within city limits, please call me at 530-538-2420 and we will set up a meeting time.
