

**CITY OF OROVILLE
ORDINANCE NO. 1845**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OROVILLE, AMENDING SECTION 17.16.060 OF THE OROVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE ADDING SUBSECTION C,5, DISASTER RECOVERY TEMPORARY USES AND AMENDING THE CURRENT FEE SCHEDULE BY ADDING THE ASSOCIATED FEE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OROVILLE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 17.16.060 is hereby added to the Oroville Municipal Code as follows:

17.16.060 Temporary Uses and Buildings

A. Applicability. All temporary uses and buildings are required to obtain a use permit, except as provided in this section.

C. Uses Subject to Administrative Permit.

The following temporary uses and buildings, which are required to obtain an administrative permit, shall be subject to the following requirements:

5. Disaster Recovery Temporary Uses; Uses directly associated with an ongoing disaster.


SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance, it being expressly declared that this ordinance and each section, subsection, clause and phrase hereof would have been prepared, proposed, adopted, approved and ratified irrespective of the fact that any one or more other sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. The ordinance shall take effect upon the thirty-first (31st) day after its final passage.
